JEFFREY AHOLO APAKA June 22, 1946 - January 30, 2022



Waikiki Community Center honors Jeff Apaka, son of legendary Hawaiian music icon Alfred Apaka. Jeff was a vocalist in his own right and headlined shows at the Royal Hawaiian Hotel, Maui Surf Hotel, and most recently entertained at the Hilton Hawaiian Village.

In December 2021, Jeff received the Hawai`i Academy of Recording Arts Lifetime Achievement Award in the Monarch Room at the Royal Hawaiian Hotel.

For more than 25 years, Jeff was the Director of Community Relations at the Waikiki Community Center. He started the long-running Ala Wai Challenge, a successful community competiton/fundraiser, which later became the Duke Kahanamoku Beach Challenge at the Hilton Hawaiian Village.

Jeff was known to so many - from famous entertainers and cultural icons to WCC's kupuna, community members and staff, to his family and friends.

He touched the lives of many and will be remembered fondly.

In preparation for the return of in-person activity, we are announcing the opening of our BeST (Be STRONG TOGETHER) program. Enrollment in our BeST program will entitle you to published discounted class & activity fees in addition to complimentary admission to special activities.

RE-OPENING SPECIAL! The enrollment fee for 12-months is \$40 per person. WCC is extending a re-opening special rate of \$20 for 12 months, if registered by March 31, 2022. Please consider taking advantage of this 50% discount.

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN AT WAIKIKI COMMUNITY CENTER (during COVID-19) Please kokua by following a few requirements and guidelines while at WCC:

- Abide by temperature checks prior to entering the space where your class/activity will occur. Please
 understand that you will not be allowed into the activity space or remain on WCC property if your temperature
 registers 100.4°F or higher;
- WCC requires proof of full vaccination against COVID-19. You are considered fully vaccinated following at least two (2) doses of Pfizer or Moderna vaccines or 2 weeks following a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine;
- · Wear a face mask while on WCC property (indoor & outdoor);
- Remain a distance of at least 6 ft. from other participants;
- Please bring your personal filled bottle of water (water fountains are not available at this time);
- Eating is not allowed in any of our spaces during activity outdoor and indoor;
- There will be a 10-minute arrival and departure window for every activity. Please refrain from socializing prior to or following your activity. Mahalo for your cooperation!
