Stop 1: The First Chinese Church of Christ (1929)

Designed by renowned architect Hart Wood in the distinctive "Hawaiian Architecture" style, this church masterfully blends Eastern and Western traditions.

Stop 2: Makiki Christian Church

Founded in 1904 by Rev. Takei Okumura, this church stands alone as the only Christian church in the United States modeled after a 16th-century Japanese castle of the Edo period.
